Sadly, a few of our parent community are disrespectful of the neighbourhood which Woodlea is part of and in some cases are putting our children at risk.

A resident of Long Hill had their gate damaged by a parent reversing into it this week. This was on the private road section where none of our parents should be. This is impacting the school's relationship with the residents of Long Hill which is negatively impacting the school.

I am always courteous to those parents who need reminding not to park on the private section of Long Hill, but ultimately if I am not out, those parents think it is ok to do this. It is not ok for any reason. It is a private road, and you need to park elsewhere. As the headteacher of Woodlea, my focus should be on the teaching and learning of your children, not supervising parking.
